### **Senior Scientist**

We seek a US resident postdoctoral scientist with extensive microbiology experience together with relevant skills in the area of molecular biology. Experience of clinical microbiology and / or bacteriophage biology would also be considered valuable. The role will chiefly involve the development of bacteriophage-based therapeutic agents and consideration of the next stages of the technology.

Experience of preparing and submitting grant applications and of managing awarded grant funding would be advantageous.

This role is a senior and key element of AmpliPhi's research and development programme in bacteriophage-based biological antibiotics. The postholder will be involved with all aspects of this work up to and including support work for clinical trials and marketing applications.

The post will be based at the new laboratories of the Company at the Virginia Biotechnology Research Park in Richmond, VA. The team based at this site will focus on molecular biology and genomics and will liaise with the main company laboratory in the United Kingdom. Travel between company and other locations will be required, along with attendance at scientific meetings. Some out of hours working is likely to be required.

The post requires excellent written and oral communication skills, as well as the ability to work independently.
